In the last of our series of letters from the misioneros from the Church in La Playa (central Cuba) we hear from the church Pastor, Arnold Cabot:

'It is a privilege to be able to write to you again so that you can see how our small group of misioneros are progressing.

The church here has a congregation of 68, and we hold a prayer meeting every morning for 30 minutes, as well as after work on occasions when we feel led.

Thanks to God things are going well, although not always how we would want as we are imperfect beings and this town is a little atheistic. We find people seem afraid to come to church and believe in God. I include a photo of the roof of the pastoral house- it is rotten and full of holes- it would be a huge blessing to myself and the whole church if you could help us to repair it.
